This 6-hour course will provide information on how to install a roughed in, passive or full mitigation radon system in a new home. The course will provide details on how to decide which system to install and how to perform this "roughed-in" installation and meet the National Building Code of Canada.

The 2010 National Building Code adopted in New Brunswick on January 2015 requires that all new homes be constructed in such a way as to minimize soil gas ingress including Radon into the home and make it easy and economical to correct should it be determined that there is a Radon problem after occupancy.
