



C-NRPP's new continuing education program is now titled, "C-NRPP Professional Practice Credits" that includes changes to the requirements for maintaining certification in radon measurement and mitigation. These changes are also intended to encourage Canadian radon professionals to be involved in the radon industry's development and growth.

C-NRPP Professional Practice Credits

Radon professionals are required to accumulate credits associated with various activities which contribute to growing the radon industry in Canada through interactions with the public and other radon professionals. These credits are required for renewals every 2 years.

Requirements: (see example on page 4)

20 credits every 2 years

- 4 credits must come from C-NRPP Approved Courses
- 16 credits must come from at least 2 out of the remaining 4 categories
- Limit of 10 credits can come from the *Hands-On Category*

C-NRPP Approved Courses

This consists of courses which have been approved by C-NRPP for practice credits. This is to encourage education of radon professionals on specific radon topics. To receive credits in this category, you must submit a certificate to show you completed these course hours.

(at least 4 credits must be from this Category)

1 hr of course = 1 credit

OTHER CATEGORIES:


Community Outreach and Radon Awareness

This consists of activities which you are active in providing radon information to the community. The concept would be to encourage radon professionals to share information on radon with the public. To receive credits in this category, you must provide details of the event including the date, name, location and brief description of the event/activity and of your participation.

1hr of participation = 1 credit

It is not limited to, but can include the following activities:

1. Lunch and Learn Sessions
2. Community Information Sessions
3. Presentations at Conferences
4. Workshop Sessions
5. Client Information Sessions
6. Participation in Trade Shows

Professional Development

This consists of courses or participation in educational activities which will provide radon professionals with knowledge, information and instruction. To receive credits for this, you must provide some proof of successfully completing the course provided to you by the course provider.

1 hr of course = 1 credit

It is not limited to, but can include the following activities:

1. University Courses
2. C-NRPP Approved CE Courses
3. Online Courses
4. Attendance at workshops
5. Courses at conferences
6. Technical training courses
7. Participation in Radon Research

Radon Industry Participation

This consists of activities which will enhance and encourage development of the radon industry within Canada. To receive credits in this category, you must provide details of the event/activity including the date, name, location and brief description of the event and of your participation.

1hr of participation = 1 credit

It is not limited to, but can include the following activities:

1. CARST Committees
2. CARST Board of Directors
3. C-NRPP Policy Advisory Board
4. Radon Working Groups

Hands On Practice


This consists of practical radon work which will provide homeowners and building owners with the necessary services they require. This is to give credit for those professional who are spending time working in radon and this acknowledges the fact that working in your trade is providing opportunities to increase your knowledge and sharpen your skills as a radon professional. This must be related directly to the type of certification.

To receive credits in this category, you must provide details of the job including the date, name of the town/city, description of the services provided

1 measurement job = 1 credit

- Limit of 10 Hands-On Credits per renewal.

1 mitigation job = 2 credits
