



## Information for Examinees

Taking a course from an approved C-NRPP Trainer is a pre-requisite for certification. Proof of course completion is not required to be shown to C-NRPP before the exam is written but will be required to complete certification.

Exam time, date and location should be arranged with your proctor. Please ensure you arrive in time for registration as well as for the allowable exam time.

The test is a closed-book exam and no study or reference materials shall be brought into the exam room. Examinees can only bring the following materials:

- Two pencils
- Pencil eraser
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Simple (non-programmable) calculator
- Photo identification (i.e., Provincial driver’s license, passport, immigration card etc.)

### Exam Details:

Exam is Multiple Choice, only one answer is correct. A bubble sheet is supplied in the exam package with answers A, B, C or D. The exam question booklet and answer sheet should be returned to the package before returning to the proctor.

Time limits are set for examinations as follows:

Exam Type	Maximum Time Allotted	Number of Questions
Radon Measurement Exam	2 hours	100
Radon Mitigation Exam	3 hours	120
CNHCR – Installer’s Exam	1 hour	50

### Passing the Exam

The pass rate for the exam is 70%.

If you aren’t successful in passing the exam, you are free to re-write the exam for up to one year after completing your course. There are no limits on number of re-writes or time in between exams. At the end of a year, you will need to re-take the course before re-writing the exam.
