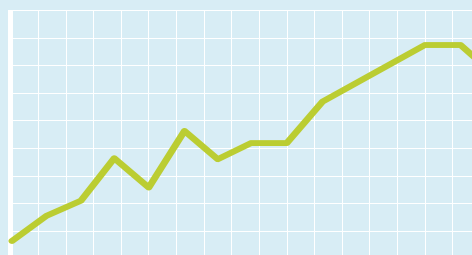


Protect Your Workplace from Radon


Radon is a gas that you can't see, smell, or taste — but it can be dangerous. It's the second leading cause of lung cancer in Canada.

4% of Federal Buildings tested were **above 200 Bq/m³**
