Find a Professional

Steps to Install a Mitigation System

- 1. Properly conduct a long term radon test.
- Find a certified professional at www.c-nrpp.ca.
- 3. Homeowner should review *Important Questions to Ask the Contractor*.
- 4. Contractor conducts *Diagnostic Testing* to ensure location for system will be effective.
- 5. Contractor explains the *System Design* and schedule of installation.
- 6. Contractor installs mitigation system.
- 7. Contractor provides a short term test to verify system effectiveness.
- 8. Homeowner conducts a long term test during the next heating season to verify radon levels are lowered.

Important Questions to Ask the Contractor

- 1. Can the contractor show proof of past work?
- 2. Can the contractor offer references?
- 3. Is the contractor insured?
- 4. Does the contractor have proof of certification?
- 5. Did the contractor conduct an inspection of your home and discuss the installation including the *Pick up Point and Discharge* locations for the system?
- 6. Did the contractor adequately explain the process of *Diagnostic Testing* and *System Design*?
- 7. Can the contractor sufficiently explain a plan and schedule for the work being done?
- 8. Does the contractor include a follow up radon test or detector to ensure effectiveness of the system?
