(currently available only for the CRNCH Exam and Radon Measurement Exam)

Exam Details

Exam is Multiple Choice, only one answer is correct. A bubble sheet is supplied in the exam package with answers A, B, C or D. The exam question booklet and answer sheet should be returned to the package before returning to the proctor.

Ordering the Exam

Complete an order form and proctor security agreement, email to exams@c-nrpp.ca.

The exam will be couriered to your proctor on the date of the exam.

Cost Individual Online Exam:

CRNCH: \$75 per exam

- (includes proctor fees)

Cost Individual Exam:

- Measurement and Mitigation: \$200

- CRNCH \$125

Cost Group of exams (2 or more):

- Measurement and Mitigation:

o \$200 Shipping + \$55/exam

CRNCH Exam - \$100 + \$25/exam

(Proctor fee is the responsibility of the examinee or group.)

Measurement Exam: \$175 per exam - (Includes proctor fees)

Attaining a Proctor

The proctor could be a librarian, school teacher, university professor or principal. The proctor cannot be a relative, close friend, employee, employer or supervisor or teacher of the course for which you are taking the exam.

Once you have established who the proctor will be and have a location and date, complete the attached order form and email back to me the completed "One-Write Proctors Security Agreement" signed by the proctor and the "One-Write Exam Order form" at least 2 weeks before your exam date.

Once you have ordered and paid the exam fees through C-NRPP, we will email you information to create an account on the Proctor U website, schedule your exam, and a proctor will be assigned to you.

Materials Required

- Two pencils
- Pencil eraser
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Simple (non-programmable) calculator
- Photo identification (i.e., Provincial driver's license, passport, immigration card etc.)
- PC Users: A well-working computer running Windows Vista or higher with 1024 MB of RAM or higher.
- Mac Users: A well-working computer running Mac OS X or higher.
- A web cam
- Headphones or working speakers
- A microphone connected to the computer
- A reliable high speed internet connection
- A web browser with Adobe Flash Player installed. (more precise specifications are offered on the ProctorU website)

Passing Exam

The pass rate for the exam is 70%.

If you aren't successful in passing the exam, you are free to re-write the exam again up to one year after completing your course. There are no limits on number of re-writes or time in between exams. If one year passes before you pass the exam, you will need to re-take the course before re-writing the exam.

Exam Results

Once your exam results are available they will be posted online at: www.c-nrpp.ca/how-to-become-certified/exam-results-3

Pass/Fail will be shown online, and your detailed exam results will be mailed to you at the address you provide on the roster, signed at the time of the exam. Please ensure the address is correct and that you provide an email address.

You will receive your results immediately after completing the exam.
